 We will apply for a Class A license.
 - A motion to allow our Treasurer to automatically transfer funds in excess of \$5,000 from our checking account to our Vanguard money market account was approved. (Nettie motioned/Kathy second).

Treasurer's Report was reviewed and approved (Kathy motioned/Nettie second).

4. Library Director's Report.

- Carla is seeking permission from the Village to put bookshelves in the hallway which will allow for ongoing book sales.
- Upcoming Events
 - July & August: SLP will continue through July; Battle of the Books is scheduled on July 31; SLP prize drawings will begin in August; August

- Adult programming includes Craft, Genealogy, Frauds & Scams as well as weekly drawings for APT tickets.
- September & October: "The Repurposed Library" and Any Book Club will be offered in September. October events include: Banned Book Club and a Veronica Hinke Edar Allen Poe program.
- Author Fair is planned for November.

5. Upcoming Fundraisers.

- The Silent Pie Auction is scheduled for July 22, 2025 during the Neil Diamond
 Concert in the Park.
- We have decided to raise the "buy early" price to \$50.00 per pie and the opening bid for all pies to \$25.00. Bidding will begin at 5:30 PM and will run until intermission at approximately 7:30 PM.

• Other changes:

- With the Star News (now Times Tribune) reorganization, there are no longer free press releases for fundraisers.
 - The Board approved one ad (designed by newspaper) to run the Thursday before our event as well as a front page ad on the July 22 Buyer's Guide for \$59.24.
- Annette will announce the Pie Auction at both the July 15th and July
 22nd concerts.
- Kathy will distribute reminders/"how to bid" slips during the July 22nd concert.
- Communication: TDS emails bounce back when any solicitation like "Silent
 Auction" is mentioned in either the subject line or body of the email. This has

impacted communication with 24 friends. Kathy will try to send a "Pie Event" email with the silent auction information included as an attachment.
